



Course Description: Students were engaged in self-directed research in the form of written, and creative projects specific to their discipline; Fine Art, Design, Art History, or Graphic Illustration. These projects developed in consultation with the Instructor. Students developed oral and visual presentations, and participate in class critiques. Art majors were required to complete and finalize their portfolios, and E-portfolios, made up of representative examples of studio work.

Course Reflection: In this class we really got to experiment with different mediums and ideas. I really got to know myself better after this because I never knew how much fun it was to use mixed mediums.
